Drew up a rough volunteer grid of known stalls and volunteers, and drew up a list of 19 volunteers based on questionnaire responses. Marie to fill names in gaps and check people are happy with that. Agreed to have school playground gates closed but not locked, but someone to man them. 'Gate man' is a job on the volunteer grid, as is 'sponsor climbing wall'. Hayley needs to know which games we'd like to borrow: Splat the rat Stocks (ask Yr 6 if they would like to run that) (Update: they said yes) ?Hook a duck? Toddlers running their own stall, including sorting own float and profit. Nursery now mixed in with the rest of the school ie not own stall. Emma's friend would like to have an external stall for £15 'Tropical Skin' and also offers a % of profits. Emma to ask Andre at farm shop if they would donate: Sausages and baps for BBQ (see below) Scones etc unsold by the end of the day Car parking BBQ: Johnson family have offered their BBQ again. Ed Bond will do 5.30pm – 6.30pm slot – Zoe to ask Ben Hanbury to join him, ask Adam Johnson if he will do earlier slot, ask Hanburys if they have a BBQ to borrow as also just around the corner. Ask Lichfield family if we can borrow theirs again.) <u>Date of Next Meeting all about Summer Fair 9am Fri 10 June at school</u> <u>Monday update:</u> Marie has created a 'Master Event Bible' for Summer/Christmas Fair. Using it now. Co-ordinate Summer Fair 2016=Marie, Deputy is Zoe. Raffle prizes to be listed in order of draw ie no choice – this is suitable as we are selling tickets to people who won't be coming to Fair. Climbing wall has received £40+25+20 of donations, no information on bouncy slide. If it rains we don't get refund but get wall another date. e.g. Summer Picnic. Farm Shop has donated 100 sausages. Zoe to buy 100 Jackson finger rolls and ketchup etc from co-op. Some Yr 7 siblings accepted invitation to come back to man stalls. Put popular stall such as plant stall in unused corner such as games shed corner. Agreed to use all/most raffle prizes straight away and not hold any back. <u>Subsequent update:</u> Climbing Wall booked Sarah Dadswell has agreed to bring curry stall for £15. Suggesting masala dosas as these are a great light meal, like a filled crispy pancake with chutneys on the side.
